Marina Improvements



Summer Boat Maintenance Items



Even though we are still able to get Non-Ethanol unleaded fuel, we still recommend fuel water separators - talk to Mark or Adam in the office about this preventative measure that can really make a difference in your boat's performance and provide an extra layer of protection for your boat engine's carburetors or fuel injectors.

Please remember that keeping your boat tuned up throughout the boating season not only reduces the risk of down time but also improves fuel efficiency.
